LORD HOWE ISLAND

Here I am, sitting on a bench overlooking the breathtakingly beautiful Emerald Lagoon, gazing west towards Australia. It could be a million miles away but it's only 400km 'hop' east from Port Macquarie. I smile as I recall something our island guide said, "Australia is an island off the west coast of Lord Howe Island".

With a total land area of just under 15 square kilometres and a population of around 400, Lord Howe Island is tiny. However, we learned on our recent stay that Lord Howe Island is ranked within the top 5 holiday destinations. Now I can see why! The locals are very welcoming and proud of their island and delight showing you around, explaining how hard they work keeping their little piece of paradise just that... paradise.

Even though the island is small it is jam-packed with things to do; bird watching, snorkelling, paddle boarding, kayaking, golf, fish feeding, boat cruises to see the Turtles and view the coral, walking trails, bike riding or simply relax on a beach.

For the locals, island life does have some challenges. All supplies come by boat each fortnight from Port Macquarie weather and tide permitting. Locals shop for groceries on-line which is delivered on each boat.

A school on Lord Howe (children all walk barefoot to school) caters for primary education however, when a child reaches secondary education, parents make the agonising decision whether to home school or send their children to boarding

school on the mainland.

Our visit to Lord Howe was beautiful and the weather was absolutely perfect. We managed to view the red tailed tropical birds, sooty terns, masked boobies and see some of the fluffy little young ones on Roach Island.

With my weak stomach, I was pretty stoked to complete the boat tour around the island without feeling nauseous! We cruised to Mutton Bird Island, saw Balls Pyramid in the distance and the sheer peaks of Gower Mountain which people climb to take in the views.

I'm so glad I got the opportunity to host this tour to Lord Howe Island. The trip was made even more special thanks to our local guides, Peter and Rambling Ron and to all the friendly locals. But it was the other members of the Stonestreets Travel group who I wish to thank for making my trip to Lord Howe Island THE BEST!
